To whom it may concern

I am a resident at 41 Little George Street Thorndon. Every Sunday morning I walk to Sacred Heart Cathedral on Hill Street via Tinakori Road between 8.30am and 9.00am.

Almost every Sunday morning there is a number of traffic wardens walking the streets checking car tires. In February/March 2010 I received an infringement for exceeding the 2 hour limit on Little George Street between 8am at 10.20am one Sunday morning. This was not a weekend of a stadium match, and there were no other cars parked in the street at the time.

Whilst I understand the importance of protecting Thorndon residents parking from stadium events – I feel the current system to be excessive and unnecessary.

The TRA hasn't had an opportunity to formally develop an Association position on P120 parking restrictions and weekend parking ... however, in the time available you have (through the email dialogue below) some raw-form feedback and experiences from members of the Association's Traffic sub-committee.

Please note however, that overall, traffic and parking is a major and complex issue on the Association's agenda.

You can see that there is an issue on weekends with traffic and parking for residents (and their guests). It seems that on weekends, at least in parts of Thorndon, it can be a case of feast or famine regarding the availability of car parks ... not a problem for residents who have parking permits, but definitely an issue at times for their weekend guests or residents who do not have parking permits (or similar). Possibly more of an issue in streets impacted by weekend Stadium patrons

Hopefully this feedback is useful to you.

Sorry for the delay in response – been out of action for the past few days.

I support the extension of the P120 rule in the weekend. Living where we are on Tinakori Road our visitors usually have to park on private property (usually our neighbours (with their permission) who have plenty of off street parks (around 3 – 4 parks). When this is not the case and these parks are not used we usually have the embarrassing situation of a parking ticket for our guests because they have parked longer than 2 hours when simply having a Sunday lunch with us. Stadium events are of course the only time when parks tend to fill in our neighbourhood , as otherwise usually there is parking for Africa.

**Request for information regarding the Thorndon Coupon Parking Area..**

Thank you for your email to the Wellington City Council received on 26 January 2011 requesting information relating to the Thorndon Coupon Parking Area.

Your request asked a number of questions that I will address in order.

- **Year of establishment.**

The Council approved a modified parking management scheme for the Thorndon residential and commercial areas in 1999. This was to protect these areas from potential adverse effects of parking generated by future events being held at the Westpac stadium.

The resulting Thorndon Coupon Parking Zone was created by resolution of the Council in November 1999.

The parking zone created both a coupon parking zone where vehicles may be parked using coupons, and a P90 parking restriction (except for authorised vehicles).

Authorised vehicles were defined as vehicles displaying a valid Thorndon residents parking permit or any valid exemption permit issued by the Council for use within the Thorndon Coupon Parking Zone.

- **Reasons for the time restrictions on Saturdays and Sundays.**

As outlined in the answer above, the zone was established to protect the area from the potential adverse effects of parking generated by events being held at the stadium.

Stadium events can take place on both Saturday and Sunday and include both daytime and evening events.

- **Reasons for time restrictions applying until 9pm daily.**

9pm was chosen to discourage parking related to events being held at the stadium occurring or extending into the evening.

- **Any implications of the stadium upon parking policy in Thorndon.**

If I have understood your question correctly, the Council was asked by both local resident and business groups to address the potential for stadium related parking to adversely impact on both the commercial and residential areas which would provide convenient parking for people attending events at the stadium.

The raising of these concerns led to the introduction of the coupon parking zone.

- **What reviews, if any, have been undertaken.**

A recent review of parking along Thorndon Quay has been undertaken and assessment suggests the parking limit could be raised from P90 to P120 without adversely affecting businesses.

No review has been carried out in the residential areas of Thorndon covered by the Thorndon Coupon Parking Scheme as there has been no pressure to do so and the scheme is considered to be achieving its intended purpose.

- **The number of parking tickets issued in relation to vehicles exceeding the time limits (and the percentage of which the registered address of those vehicles is in Thorndon).**

Unfortunately, this information is not easily retrievable and will require substantial collation. The Council's contractor is currently compiling this information and this will be forwarded to you once it is available.

- **Along with any other information relevant to the establishment and maintenance of the Thorndon Coupon Parking Area, under s 10 (1) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.**

No further information relating to this issue is held.
