## For all three premises

- 1. Apply principle 10 (p19 DLAP): not to reduce existing licence conditions except where explicitly stated
  - (a) To preserve 24/7 licences currently existing.
  - (b) Add an explicit category to the table (p27 DLAP) for:
    - Adult entertainment/strip club premises and brothels
      authorizing hours
    - "At any time on any day"

Similar to hotels and airport bars.

- 2. Allow discretion for no public hearing of renewals in Entertainment Precinct where no public objections, no identification of high/medium risk by reporting agencies. These three premises are low-risk trouble free previously renewed on the papers as no objections/opposition. (See p29 DLAP). May just need clarification as to whether *Note* overrides what is set out earlier (see p29).
- 3. Recognition that *Adult Entertainment* and *Brothel* licensed venues are completely different from licensed bar venues, for the purposes of conditions. (p33 DLAP). eg. "wind down" "1 way door"

- 4. In addition to the above:
  - The definition/boundary of the Entertainment Precinct needs adjustment by one property to include 146 Vivian Street see maps.
