TAWA PRIMARY SCHOOLS' CITIZENSHIP AWARDS

1. Purpose of Report

To ensure funding for the Tawa Primary Schools' Citizenship Awards. In March 2011 the Tawa Community Board agreed to fund these awards on an annual basis. Funding by the community board for the 2012 awards needs to be confirmed.

2. Recommendations

It is recommended that the Tawa Community Board:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Agree to continue funding the Tawa Primary Schools' Citizenship Awards on an annual basis and that they be funded from the Tawa Discretionary Fund – C590.

3. Background

The Tawa Primary Schools' Citizenship Awards were first held in 2011. The 2012 ceremony will be held on 30 November with the Mayor of Wellington presenting the awards to the winners from the six primary schools plus the Intermediate.

The ongoing yearly cost was originally estimated to be around \$1075. The cost in 2012 will not exceed that amount and, in fact, may be reduced by \$200 if sponsorship of book vouchers is gained again.

Trophies, shield lettering, certificates and photo frames are likely to total \$700. In addition to that, we have allowed \$150 for catering and \$200 for book vouchers (if sponsorship is not retained), a total of \$1050.
