### **Tawa Community Board Monthly Report – October 2007**

#### **Woolworths – Oxford Street Flooding**

The Oxford Street sump has been re-inspected and found to be clear of debris. The sump will be maintained regularly to avoid further flooding issues. Pita King is the contact officer at Council for such issues.

#### **Tawa/Linden Plunket – Open Day for Duncan Park Playground**

The Duncan Park Playground is due for completion near the end of October 2007. Council has advised Tawa/Linden Plunket that they are welcome to organise their open day from mid November onwards. Officers will continue to liaise with Tawa/Linden Plunket in preparations for the open day.

#### **BMX Track Upgrade**

The BMX track upgrade project has been on hold due to staff changes. The project has now been taken up by Jacqui Murray of Council's Parks department. A contractor has been scheduled for the earthworks project and it is anticipated that the project will be completed over the next few months.

#### **Parking Issues**

The Tawa Community Board Working Party and the Tawa Roothing Party will be invited to meetings with Council to address parking issues. It is expected that this meeting will take place in late October.

#### **Vehicle crossing repairs**

A query was raised as to why some vehicle crossings in Oriel Ave were being repaired and some were not. Vehicle crossings are not typically maintained by Council. Recently, some vehicle crossings were damaged by contractors whilst completing other work; these damaged crossings have/are being repaired at the contractor's cost.

#### **Shopping Centre Bollards**

As there are no removable bollards outside the Tawa Centre, a removable bollard has been ordered from the supplier and will be installed in four weeks. Emergency access is possible via the rear car park access way.

#### **Safer Roads Programme**

The Safer Roads Programme was implemented in Tawa four years ago where approximately one million dollars was spent within Tawa on road safety initiatives. The Safer Roads Programme is currently focusing on Newtown and

Island Bay and is scheduled to be completed in 2023. There is no provision to return to Tawa before that time.

### **Community Centre Advisory Group**

Now that the Tawa Community Centre Open Day is complete, it is anticipated that the Community Centre Advisory Group will be formed within two weeks.

The Tawa Community Centre Open Day was a great success with a total of 1,970 visitors on the day. There were 76 communities and community groups involved in the opening and a team of 37 volunteers.

There was only one emergency throughout the day where a lady collapsed. The first aid team and the local fire brigade were able to stabilise and comfort her until an ambulance arrived. The lady recovered after some time with the paramedics.

### **Tawa Street**

A resident has queried why they have not yet received a response to their letter regarding road safety concerns at Tawa Street. A letter dated 27<sup>th</sup> September has been sent to the resident advising that Council officers have inspected the site and consider the vehicle crossing to be safe. Parked cars on the street do affect sight lines however parking spaces are at a premium on Tawa Street.

### **Mervyn Kemp Plaque**

The dedication plaque in honour of former Tawa Mayor Mervyn Kemp has been designed and will be ready for installation by 15 October 2007. The plaque will read:

ERNEST MERVYN HALL KEMP

Mayor of Tawa 1955-1984, the greater part of its time as a Borough. First chairman of the Wellington Regional Council 1977-1983. For his services to the community Mervyn Kemp was awarded the CBE, MBE, and Paul Harris award. Locally he has been honoured in the naming of Tawa's library.
