
CREATIVE COMMUNITIES WELLINGTON LOCAL FUNDING SCHEME: ALLOCATIONS FOR 2006/07

1. Purpose of Report

This report informs the Subcommittee of the allocations made under the Creative Communities Wellington Local Funding Scheme for 2006/07, as is required under our contract with Creative New Zealand.

3. Background

Each year Creative New Zealand gives \$100,000 to the Council to administer on their behalf under the Creative Communities Wellington Local Funding Scheme. 111 applications were received in 2006/07 and of these 89 were approved.

Attached as Appendix 1 is a list of successful applicants, how much they received and a description of their project. Under the agreement between the Council and Creative New Zealand the decisions on funding are made by a committee of community representatives with one Councillor elected to the committee each triennium. The scheme is a valuable addition to the Council's existing arts grants scheme as it targets grassroots type projects that would not fit current Council grants criteria.
