The Temporary Road Closures Subcommittee will meet on Thursday 14 February to consider the following road closures:

Stage 5 of Women's Tour of Wellington, Saturday 1 March, 8am-2pm

- Shelly Bay Road and Massey Road (Miramar cutting to Karaka Bay Road)
- Karaka Bay Road (Massey Road to Awa Road)
- Awa Road (Karaka Bay Road and Para Street)
- Para Street (between Rex Street and Rotherham Terrace)
- Rex Street (Tauhinu Road to Para Street)
- Tauhinu Road (between Rex Street and Miramar Avenue)
- Miramar Avenue (between Cobham Drive and Shelly Bay Road)
- Tauhinu Road will be open for northbound traffic only heading towards Cobham Drive.

Stop/go control will be in place at Park and Rex Street.

Double stop/go control will be in place at the Darlington Road, Awa Road, Rex Street and Para Road sections.

Stop/go control will also be at the Nevay Road, Awa Road and Seatoun Heights Road intersections.

This is to allow vehicles to cross the course in a controlled manner.
