**ANZAC DAY COMMEMORATIONS, WELLINGTON CITY
25 APRIL 2008**

1. Description of Event

The Wellington Returned And Services Association (inc) and the N.Z. Police have requested the closure of the following roads to commemorate ANZAC Day:

- Bunny Street (Featherston Street to Lambton Quay) and Lambton Quay (both sides from Bunny Street & Molesworth Street to the Corner of Whitmore Street & Bowen Street) from 5am until 6:30am for the **Dawn Parade**.
- Molesworth Street (from Hill Street to Lambton Quay/Bunny Street intersection) and Lambton Quay (western side between Molesworth Street and Bowen Street – Cenotaph) between 10:15am and 10:45am for the **Wreath Laying Ceremony**.

2. City Events Support

This is an annual event, supported in the past by the Council.

3. Proposal Notice

4. Objections

5. Traffic Impact Assessment


Prior Closures

None of the proposed closures for this event will result in a road being closed for an aggregate of more than 31 days in any year.

Traffic Impact

In the opinion of Soon Teck Kong, Manager Transport Network, acting as the Council's Traffic Engineer, the proposed closure, if implemented according to the plans provided, is not likely to impede traffic unreasonably. However, the


Council reserves the right to modify this opinion at any time. If, in the opinion of the Council, the closure may or does impede traffic unreasonably, any approval granted by the Temporary Road Closures Subcommittee may be revoked and the event organiser may be required to open the road at the direction of a suitably qualified Council officer in charge of traffic.
