

# OUR ACTIVITIES IN DETAIL

 Over the next few pages, you'll find information about our plans for 2008/09.

Our work is divided into seven strategic areas:

## Urban development

Urban planning and policy, building control and facilitation, development control and facilitation, earthquake risk mitigation, and public spaces development.

## Transport

Transport planning and policy, transport networks, and parking.

## Economic development

City promotions, events and attractions, and business support.

## Environment

Gardens and beaches, green open spaces, water, wastewater, waste reduction and energy conservation, environmental conservation attractions, and the quarry.

## Cultural well-being

Heritage, galleries and museums, community arts and cultural support, and arts partnerships.

## Social and recreation

Housing, recreation facilities and programmes, libraries, public health and safety, and community support.

## Governance

Engagement with Maori, and information, consultation and decision-making.

In each chapter you'll find information about the work we do, the reasons for doing that work and/or our goals in relation to it, any new proposals for 2008/09, capital and operational costs, and our performance targets (i.e. our targets for quantity, quality and breadth of service).

Our levels of service for 2008/09 will be broadly in line with 2007/08. Any proposed changes from current levels are explained in the following pages (see the sections on our proposed new initiatives and variances).

We've done our best to provide information that is meaningful and relevant, and to present this information as clearly as possible, so that you – Wellington's residents – can be informed about our proposed programme, and make your voice heard.
