

PROPOSED DISTRICT PLAN CHANGE 13 – FUTUNA CHAPEL – 62 FRIEND STREET; KARORI

WELLINGTON CITY DISTRICT PLAN

In accordance with the Resource Management Act 1991, notice is given of Proposed District Plan Change 13 to the Wellington City District Plan.

The purpose of District Plan Change 13 is to amend the Heritage listing of Futuna Chapel on page 21/24 of the Operative District Plan to provide for the listing of the whole interior and all movable fittings and furniture forming the fabric and spatial qualities of the Chapel and an area of land around the Chapel.

The current listing of the Chapel does not include the interior or the setting of the Chapel. The Plan Change includes an Appendix to the Heritage Rules and makes the following a Discretionary Activity (Unrestricted):

- additions and alterations to Futuna Chapel
- total or partial demolition, destruction or removal
- the construction of any buildings or structures on an area of land around the Chapel

Any person may make a submission on this Proposed District Plan Change. This must be in writing on the form prescribed (Form 3) in the Resource Management (Forms) Regulations 1991 or similar. Forms are available from the above locations or will be mailed to you if you phone 499 4444, or email Barbara.Fill@wcc.govt.nz.

Once the submission period has closed, the Council will prepare and publicly notify a summary of the submissions. There will be an opportunity for anyone to make a further submission in support or opposition to any of the submissions. A hearing will then be arranged to consider submissions of both types, and recommendations will be made. Anyone who has made a submission can attend the hearing and present his or her submission. Anyone who has made a submission can also appeal against a Council decision to the Environment Court.
