**PROPOSED DISTRICT PLAN CHANGE 15 – AIRPORT CURFEW
EXEMPTION RULES**

WELLINGTON CITY DISTRICT PLAN

In accordance with the Resource Management Act 1991, notice is given of Proposed District Plan Change 15 to the Wellington City District Plan.

The purpose of Proposed District Plan Change 15 is to amend the airport curfew exemption rules to provide New Zealand heads of state and New Zealand senior dignitaries with the same level of dispensation to the night flying curfew that currently exists for foreign heads of state and foreign senior dignitaries.

Any person may make a submission on this Proposed District Plan Change. This must be in writing on the form prescribed (Form 3) in the Resource Management (Forms) Regulations 1991 or similar. Once the submission period has closed, the Council will prepare and publicly notify a summary of the submissions. There will be an opportunity for anyone to make a further submission in support or opposition to any of the submissions. A hearing will then be arranged to consider submissions of both types, and recommendations will be made. Anyone who has made a submission can attend the hearing and present his or her submission. Anyone who has made a submission can also appeal against a Council decision to the Environment Court.
