PROPOSED DISTRICT PLAN CHANGE 17 – Evans Bay Patent Slip Area

WELLINGTON CITY DISTRICT PLAN

Clause 7 of First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991

The Wellington City Council has prepared the following summary of submissions on Proposed Plan Change 17 – Evans Bay Patent Slip Area and this is now available for public inspection.

Plan Change 17 involves a number of land rezoning and a road re-alignment in order to facilitate changes to the Evans Bay Patent Slip area. The opportunity is also taken to protect Patent Slip No. 2 area by establishing a heritage area. Eleven submissions were received and these generally cover two issues – the nature of land zoning for land to be sold by the Council and the extent of the proposed heritage area.

The process for public participation in the consideration of the proposed plan change under the Act from this point is as follows:

- € there will be an opportunity to make a further submission in support of, or in opposition to, the submissions already made; and
- € if a person making a submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission, a hearing must be held; and
- € the Council will give its decision on the proposed plan change (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions); and
- € any person who has made a submission or a further submission has the right to appeal the decision on the proposed plan change to the Environment Court.
