- The Council will only release the bond to the nominated account or authorised person stated on this form.
- The Council may recover any costs (including GST) associated with remedial works required as a consequence of any posters, signs or hoardings placed by or for the applicant in a public place in any electoral district or ward by reducing the amount of bond to be returned to the applicant. In the event that the total cost to the Council to carry out such remedial works exceeds the bond amount the additional cost can be recovered from the applicant.
- Prior to carrying out any remedial works the Council will provide the applicant with reasonable opportunity to carry out such works at the applicant's cost.
- A detailed cost breakdown (including a GST receipt) will be provided to justify any reduction in bond returned.

## Declaration

I hereby declare that I am authorised to act on behalf of the applicant, the party and/or the candidate named above and undertake to comply with the conditions stated above and the conditions listed in the Wellington City Council Guidelines for Temporary Signs in Public Places.
