- All dogs in my possession will be kept and controlled in accordance with the requirements of the Dog Control Act 1996 and the Wellington Consolidated Bylaw 1991 Part 3 (Animals).
- A licence may be subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as the Council may from time to time consider necessary to impose.
- I am aware that any breach of these conditions may lead to immediate cancellation of my licence.

Dog Control Bylaws 1997

LICENCE REQUIRED FOR MORE THAN THREE DOGS

- No owner or occupier of any premises can keep, for any period exceeding seven days, more than three dogs over the age of three months. This is whether or not they are registered, and whether or not he or she is the registered owner of the dogs, without a licence from the Council
- The Council may issue a licence to keep more than three dogs subject to such terms, conditions, and restrictions as the Council may consider necessary for the protection of other persons or property from being affected in any way by the dogs.
- Any person seeking to keep more than three dogs on premises may make written application to the Council for a licence and shall provide the Council with such information as it may require to determine the application.
- A fee for a licence issued in terms of this clause will be payable on the issue of the licence and then payable annually.
