Photos must feature a rose or roses. All photos must be received **no later than 9am on Friday 27 November 2009**.

CATEGORIES

1. General
2. Photo by a child up to 14 years old
3. Photo by a senior citizen

THE PRIZES ARE

SUBMISSIONS

Each submission should include a colour print measuring either 7" x 5" or 6" x 4", the photographer's name and contact details, a negative/digital file, and a 25-word or less description of the photo. Photographs must be original, unaltered in any way, and have been taken solely for the purpose of this contest. A photo may not be submitted twice. Proof-of-age may be required for categories 2 and 3. Wellington City Council reserves the right to reject photos not meeting contest criteria.

JUDGING

Photos submitted will be judged on Friday 27 November, 2009 by independent judges. Winners will be announced at 1pm on 27 November, in the Begonia House. Winners will also be contacted by phone, email or letter, with the winning photos going on display in the Treehouse Visitor Centre.

All entries will be judged by an impartial panel of judges. Winners will be selected on originality and artistic merit.

Submitted photos will become the property of Wellington City Council. The Council reserves the right to use the supplied image in print and electronic form to promote the Botanic Garden in New Zealand and internationally. Winners may be required and must be willing to participate in publicity/media associated with the contest. Entrants are responsible for all costs in taking and submitting photos.
