

Stanley Banks Bequest 2009

About the fund

In 1949 Stanley Banks left a bequest to Wellington City Council for children of returned service people from the Second World War, in memory of his son who died during the war. The fund is administered by Heritage Inc on the Council's behalf. Grants from the Stanley Banks Bequest are to assist eligible students with education costs. Tuition can be in any discipline but must be NZQA accredited.

Criteria

Applicants must:

- be children of New Zealand soldiers, sailors or airmen who fought in WWII
- qualify for a community services card or demonstrate need
- live in the Wellington region
- show that the grant is needed to meet study costs
- be enrolled in an NZQA accredited course
