- A copy of your original manager's certificate and**
- A copy of your most recent renewal certificate [if applicable].**

If your manager's certificate has expired, it cannot be renewed. You must make application for a new manager's certificate.

Note: File this application with the District Licensing Agency nearest to the licensed premises where you intend to work. In other cases, file the application with the agency nearest to where you live.

**The application is to be signed only by the applicant or the applicant's solicitor NOT an agent.
