

## Trade Waste Fees – Year 2007/2008

Trade Waste Fees set under section 690A of the Local Government Act 1974

### A. Trade Waste Fees:

1. Annual Licensing as per the following table:

CLASS	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>FEE</u>
<b>Application Fee</b>	No fee for Grease and Grit traps. All other consents - minimum fee of \$161.25 for all consents. Additional charge of \$107.50/hour for over 1 hour's processing time and for all costs in approving the application. All monitoring/laboratory charges payable at cost.	\$161.25
<b>A</b>	Where a discharge of trade waste, or where materials are stored such that a spillage has a high risk of discharge to the sewer, may cause damage to the sewer or treatment plant, injury to an operator or have a deleterious effect on the environment and/or maximum 24 flow volume exceeds 1000 litres and/or where a discharge of trade waste is 75 - 100% of the maximum allowable treated discharge under Schedule I of the Wellington Trade waste bylaw 1992.	\$1612.50
<b>B</b>	Where a discharge of trade waste or where materials are stored such that a spillage has a moderate risk of discharge to the sewer may cause damage to the sewer or treatment plant, injury to an operator or have a deleterious effect on the environment and/or maximum 24 flow volume exceeds 100 litres and/or where a discharge of trade waste is 25-75% of the maximum allowable treated discharge under Schedule I of the Wellington trade waste Bylaw 1992.	\$806.25
<b>C</b>	Where a discharge of trade waste or where materials are stored such that a spillage has a low risk of discharge to the sewer may cause damage to the sewer or treatment plant, injury to an operator or have a deleterious effect on the environment and/or where a discharge of Trade waste is up to 25% of the maximum allowable treated discharge under Schedule I of the Wellington trade waste bylaw 1992.  Where restaurants' grease traps are discharging more than 500 g/m <sup>3</sup> of BOD or suspended solids and/or than 100 g/m <sup>3</sup> animal oil, fat and grease.	\$ 268.75
<b>Minimal Risk</b>	Where a discharge of trade waste or where materials are stored such that there is no risk of discharge or spillage to the sewer and/or where there is a grit trap pre-treatment facility such as those used by service stations for car wash facilities.	\$ 86
<b>Grease Traps</b>	Where food premises are required to pre-treat their waste by means of a grease trap to prevent a blockage or damage to the sewer.	\$ 107.50
	Shared Grease trap - charge per food premise that share a common grease trap	\$26.88

## **Trade Waste Fees – Year 2007/2008**

### **2. Additional charges:**

- The actual and reasonable costs of undertaking sampling and testing to monitor compliance with each bylaw consent.
- A proportional fee may be applied to those premises which commence operating part way through the financial year or for those premises granted an interim or conditional consent.

### **3. Collection and Transport of Trade Waste:**

- Application fee \$134.38
- Annual License fee \$161.25
- Monitoring Lab charges. Actual.

Additional charge of \$107.50/hour for over 1 hour's processing time and for all costs in approving the application. All monitoring/laboratory charges payable at cost.
