

# TRADE WASTE FEES

Trade waste fees are set under section 690A of the Local Government Act 1974

## 1. Annual licensing as per the following table

Class	Description	Fee
Application Fee	No fee is charged for grease and grit traps. There is a minimum fee of \$180 for all consents. An additional fee of \$125 an hour will be made if processing time takes more than one hour. Additional costs, including monitoring, laboratory and extra work will be charged at their actual cost.	\$180
A	This fee will be charged when there is a discharge of trade waste, or where materials are stored in such a way that there is a high risk of spillage to the sewer, or it may cause damage to the sewer or treatment plant, injury to an operator or have a deleterious effect on the environment. When maximum 24 flow volume exceeds 1000 litres and/or where a discharge of trade waste is 75-100 percent of the maximum allowable treated discharge under Schedule 2 of the Wellington Trade Waste Bylaw 2004.	\$1800
B	This fee will be charged when there is a discharge of trade waste, or where materials are stored in such a way that there is a moderate risk of spillage to the sewer, or it may cause damage to the sewer or treatment plant, injury to an operator or have a deleterious effect on the environment. When maximum 24 flow volume exceeds 100 litres and/or where a discharge of trade waste is 25-75 percent of the maximum allowable treated discharge under Schedule 2 of the Wellington Trade Waste Bylaw 2004.	\$895
C	This fee will be charged when there is a discharge of trade waste, or where materials are stored in such a way that there is a low risk of spillage to the sewer, or it may cause damage to the sewer or treatment plant, injury to an operator or have a deleterious effect on the environment. When a discharge of trade waste is up to 25 percent of the maximum allowable treated discharge under Schedule 2 of the Wellington Trade Waste Bylaw 2004.  This fee will be charged when a restaurants' grease trap is discharging more than 600 g/m <sup>3</sup> of BOD or suspended solids and/or more than 100 g/m <sup>3</sup> animal oil, fat and grease.	\$300
Minimal Risk	This fee will be charged when a discharge of trade waste or where materials are stored in such a way that there is no risk of discharge or spillage to the sewer and/or where there is a grit trap pre-treatment facility such as those used by service stations for car-wash facilities.	\$130
Grease Traps	This fee will be charged when food premises are required to pre-treat their waste using a grease trap to prevent a blockage or damage to the sewer.	\$130
	Shared grease trap—a charge for each food premise that shares a common grease trap.	\$65

## 2. Additional charges

Additional charges will be made for the actual and reasonable costs of undertaking sampling and testing to monitor compliance with each bylaw consent.

A proportional fee may be applied to premises that start operating part-way through the financial year, or for premises granted an interim or conditional consent.

## 3. Collection and transport of trade waste

- Application fee \$150
- Annual license fee \$180

An additional charge of \$125 will be made if processing time takes more than one hour. Additional costs, including monitoring, laboratory and extra work will be charged at their actual cost.
