Furthermore, when children are being picked up after school it becomes difficult for parents to use the turning circle, which often results in vehicles doing 3-point turns using driveways and causing much random manoeuvring/reversing while school children are walking on the adjacent footpath. Such manoeuvres and parking practices in such small area are not only inconvenient but also unsafe.

Officers therefore propose broken yellow lines at the turning circle to improve the safety of this situation.
