

PROPOSED TRAFFIC RESOLUTION

Location: Weka Street - Miramar

Proposal: Mobility park, P60, Monday to Sunday, 8am-6pm

Information: Council officers have received a request from the management of Weta Studio Tours to provide a mobility park outside the Weta Cave on Weka Street.

This popular destination is frequented by a lot of foreign and local tourists all throughout the year. A number of its visitors have struggled with the lack of a mobility parking facility for their needs.

It is proposed to provide a mobility park directly outside the venue to allow better access for mobility users.

The park will be P60 time restricted from Monday to Sunday 8am-6pm.
