- **Information:** Officers have received concerns regarding parking from the school representative of Worser Bay School. The road safety concern is especially the case during morning peak and drop-off times. Seatoun Heights Road is narrow and parking is at a premium particularly around the school entrance.

The proposal is to convert 3 unrestricted parking spaces into a drop-off 'zone', located directly opposite the school entrance. This would allow parents to drop off their kids easily during morning peak. A Kea crossing operates during this time and this will facilitate safe pedestrian access across the road. These spaces are generally occupied by school teachers and they have agreed to vacate it during the proposed drop-off times.

Council officers therefore propose to convert 3 unrestricted parking spaces to be used as a drop-off during the morning peaks.
