

I live in Southgate and do not agree with this area becoming part of Eastern Ward. Our connection is to the 'South' of the city and to Island Bay - our doctor, nearest shops, pharmacy, cafes, beaches and library are there, not in the Eastern suburbs. With reference to your FAQ about the definition of a 'community of interest' our bus services run from Island Bay (soon to run from Brooklyn) to the City and back. Although the bus service is organised under the auspices of GWRC, the way in which it connects us to other parts of the city is relevant to the way in which Southgate feels 'part of' an area. Issues such as the Island Bay cycle way are relevant to me and to the person I vote for on the City Council. I do not feel that many issues affecting the eastern suburbs would be as directly relevant to people in Southgate as the area is very different in topography and character from that of the Miramar Peninsula. Low lying Lyall and Evans Bays and Seatoun also have very different Civil Defence priorities from the hills of Southgate. In this proposal you are not recognising and protecting our community of interest - you are disregarding it.

I agree they should be bilingual but the choice of the name for the Eastern suburb reinforces my point about not agreeing to the Southgate change: your statement about the island after which it proposed to name the Eastern Suburb - 'It is a dominant landmark in the Eastern Ward, being visible from all suburbs' is not really very true of many houses in Southgate; the bush behind Islapp

Bay is much more visible to many more.

You do not include any indication of the scale of the numbers issue that has caused the suburb to be shifted from one ward to another, but I can't believe it is so significant as to warrant a change which will associate it with an entirely different part of the City. I am not against change when the reasoning is coherent and in the best interests of residents but in this proposal I fear administrative convenience is trumping logic.

Clearly, asking for public opinion on electoral boundary changes is a compulsory formality, but ultimately it is integral to a proportionately representative democracy that each ward represents an approximately equal population. Thus, the ward boundaries must change if this is not the case, regardless of opinion. RE: WCC proposed ward boundary changes for Southgate

I live on Buckley Road, in Southgate. When I moved to Wellington, I moved to this part of town very deliberately as I wished to be a part of the Island Bay community. Geographically speaking, Island Bay is tied to Southgate as there is no direct or easy road or walking path access from Southgate to Kilbirnie (the hub of Eastern Ward). There is a great big hill, several deep valleys and serpentine narrow roads in the way! There are no direct bus routes — one has to travel out of the way via Newtown or the city, and change buses — very inconvenient, time-consuming and more expensive. Introduction

1. The Wellington City Youth Council welcomes the opportunity to submit on the Representation review for the 2019 and 2022 Wellington City Council elections. We recognise the important nature of this consultation for the representation of our city, and the need to provide fair representation across the city.

Overview of Submission

- 2. The submission by the Wellington City Youth Council on the Representation Review will address the following topics:
 - a. Proposed Boundary Changes
 - b. Bilingual Ward Names

Proposed Boundary Changes

- 3. Ensuring a balanced population between the wards is essential to provide fair representation to all residents of Wellington City.
- 4. Youth Council feels these proposed boundary changes are relatively minor, and all are common sense. These changes align ward boundaries more closely with geographic and suburb boundaries. In doing so, they ensure communities or interest are protected.
- 5. We note that some ward boundaries do mean that representation is marginally outside the desired +/- 10% variance, but agree with Council that it is more important for communities of interest to not be arbitrarily split, in favour of strict compliance with the Act.
- 6. We feel these ward boundaries closely match what young people in Wellington City would broadly consider to be their 'local community'.

Bilingual Ward Names

- 7. The Youth Council would like to congratulate the Wellington City Council for proposing te reo Ward names, and endorse their adoption by Council for the 2019, and 2022 elections.
- 8. We feel this is an important first step in realising the new Te Reo Maori policy, and a significant move towards Wellington City becoming a bilingual city.
- 9. We feel Council should adopt the wide spread usage of these names as soon as possible, to encourage their usage in time for the 2019 election. Increasing the recognition of not only the new te reo Ward names, but also the background of these names, will be important in increasing their adoption.

Summary

- 10. The Wellington City Youth Council supports the proposed boundary changes to align boundaries more closely with communities of interest. The proposed changes strike a fair balance between ensuring fair representation ratios, and protecting communities of interest from being split.
- 11. The Youth Council fully support the adoption of te reo Ward names, alongside the current English names. Educational information about the names and their backgrounds should be published to increase adoption.
