First Quarter ending 30 September 2022



1. Highlights

Quarter One highlights are outlined below:

- · Completion of junior winter sport fixtures for football and rugby
- · Confirmation of 2022-23 International and Domestic schedules for the venue
- · Commencement of final works on embankment toilets and permitter fencing projects
- · Continuation of planning and works for storage facility, perimeter fence and CCTV/venue lighting
- Engagement and consultation with WCC on 10-year LTP process
- Consultation with WCC to complete a report on the history of the venue in connection with bi-lingual signage project
- Execution of Licence to Occupy with Wellington Wanderers Cricket Club for use of the Media Box as Official Club Rooms
- Progression of partnership discussions with Go Media regarding Digital Billboards and extension to Naming Rights partnership with Cello

2. Statement of Intent KPI Performance

Quarter One reflects a period of minimal activity for the Basin Reserve Trust as the ground transitions from winter to summer sport and field maintenance is conducted. The table below outlines quarter one's actuals vs targets, as well as year to date performance vs the BRT's annual targets:

Cricket Events and Practice Facility Usage

During September, the Cello Basin Reserve was used by the Firebirds and Blaze for pre-season training sessions. However, no pre-season fixtures were scheduled due to inclement weather. From October onwards usage by Cricket Wellington will significantly increase with more teams accessing the practice facilities (following daylight savings), pre-season fixtures scheduled and the commencement of the domestic cricket season.



Other Sports and Community Events

Junior Rugby and Football completed their seasons at the Cello Basin Reserve in July. This activity will commence again in 2023.

Functions

Through its contract with Black and Gold Events who manage and promote the Norwood Room and Long Room in the RA Vance Stand as a venue for conferences, meetings, weddings, celebrations, Christmas functions and team building workshops, the BRT is pleased to report that 25 functions were held in Quarter One and the venue remains in high demand.

3. Master Plan Redevelopment

The Trust continues to work with Council in progressing the vision of the Master Plan and completing key capital works projects. Projects due for completion in 2022 include:

- Embankment and Public Toilets
- Perimeter Fence Upgrades
- · Storage Facility between Old Pavilion Stand and Training Cage

Commencement and confirmation of planning for the following projects are now a priority for the Trust and Wellington City: Council:

- · Broadcast Towers
- · Sight Screens
- Picket Fence Upgrade
- · CCTV and Venue Lighting
- · Library/Boardroom Fitout
- RA Vance Exterior Painting and Signage

Quarter One reflects a period of low activity for the Basin Reserve Trust with little variance to budget in the P&L. The cash position remains strong.

Outlook
