Comments

I have serious concerns at the ability for the quarry to contain dust impacts within their boundary. Currently my home gets coated inside and out with a fine brown dust. I'm a photographer and have lived where for 20 years. This dust impacts my property, and I worry about the impact on my expensive delicate equipment, and especially my long term health from breathing this airborne particulate matter over a long period. I have tolerated these impacts as I knew then northern face of the quarry was a limited finite resource. This proposed extension of the quarry operation with rule change 83, will renew this problem into the foreseeable future, and will potentially be a lot worse as the quarrying will be in direct line of sight and prevailing wind direction. It should be noted that I have also been subject to a long history of odour problems from the abattoir at the same site, as I know many people have. Expansion of inappropriate business activity within this area is surely not desirable, especially as council has approved significant new areas of housing development around this site throughout the term of the current businesses. We should be investigating more appropriate long term sites for these businesses. I also have concerns at the huge eyesore that the new south face quarry will create as the gateway into Wellington City. It will be a direct visual contradiction to the environmental values we hold dear, and are developing, in Wellington.

I seek the following decision from Council (please give precise details)

Comments

- 1) I oppose the rezoning of the South face from open space 2 to Business 2
 - 2) If rezoning is approved then I strongly request that:
 - a. stringent controls are placed on quarrying activities based on stipulated and monitored wind speed. Any activity likely to put particulate matter into the air must be halted at moderate or greater wind speeds.
 - b. comprehensive monitoring of airborne particulate matter at the boundary of the quarry should be established, at a minimum of the prevailing wind direction sectors
 - c. analysis of the mineral content of the Kiwi Point airborne dust particles is carried out with particular regard for long term impacts on human health
 I wish to be given the chance to be heard on my submission if possible.
